

# Diana T.Y. Chung Memorial Scholarship for International Students

Scholarship Application for Fall Semester 2008  
(Application Filing Period: May 1 - September 30, 2008)

The Diana T.Y. Chung Memorial Scholarship will be awarded each fall to one incoming (new) and one current international student at SFSU. The amount of each award will vary from year-to-year, but will be no less than \$500.00 per student. The scholarship is not renewable. The award will be in the form of check made payable to the student and can be used by the student according to his/her needs. Scholarship recipients will be chosen on the basis of academic ability, financial need and willingness to promote international goodwill at SFSU. All new incoming international students must have submitted an admission application to SFSU. ## Eligibility Criteria:

1. Applicants must be in F-1 or J-1 student status.
2. Scholarship recipients must have a minimum cumulative/overall gpa of 3.25 for undergraduates; 3.5 for graduates in all coursework (not only coursework completed at SFSU).
3. Open to both new (Fall 2008) and continuing matriculated F-1/J-1 students enrolled in a bachelor's, master's or Ph.d. degree program.
4. Recipients must be enrolled in a full course of study at SFSU (12 units for undergraduates; 8 units for graduates) for the Fall 2008 Semester.
5. Scholarship is awarded in October/November contingent upon admission and verification of full-time enrollment at SFSU.

## Instructions For Applicants

1. Complete & sign the scholarship application form (see reverse side).
2. Submit two **recommendation letters** on official letterhead stationary and in English from teachers or counselors who can comment on your ability to succeed academically and socially at SFSU.
3. Submit unofficial copies of all transcripts/mark sheets of university-level coursework completed (including coursework completed at SFSU) showing courses taken, grades received, diplomas earned.
4. Completed application forms and all supporting documents **must be received no later than 5pm on September 30, 2008.** If applying by mail, applications and all supporting documents must be post marked no later than September 30, 2008. **No faxes accepted!** Incomplete applications will not be considered. - ❑ Unofficial transcripts from all university-level schools attended (including SFSU). If you are a freshman undergraduate student and SFSU is the first university that you are attending, please include an unofficial copy of your secondary school/high school records/mark sheets showing courses completed, grades earned and diplomas/certificates received.
- ❑ List of Your Academic & Athletic Achievements
- ❑ Description of Your Future Educational & Career Goals (500 Word Limit)
- ❑ Description of Your Need for Financial Assistance (250 Word Limit)
- ❑ International Goodwill Essay (500 Word Limit)
- ❑ Remember, you must be admitted and enrolled in a full course of study for the Fall 2008 Semester in order to be eligible!

**Please do not submit/mail your application until it is COMPLETE with ALL of the above!**
