2. A short essay of 400-600 words (*must adhere to this limit on the word count*) covering the following topics:  
**a) your professional goals, b) reasons for applying for this scholarship, and c) your financial need.**
3. A list of academic achievements and other activities in campus, community, or volunteer organizations.
4. **TWO** email recommendations from **professors in your major field of study** to **science@sfsu.edu**.
5. An unofficial current copy of your SFSU academic transcript.

**Evaluation** of applicants will be based on the essay/paragraph, faculty recommendation, and academic record.
