1. Student must have a declared major in the **SFSU College of Science & Engineering** (Departments of Biology, Chemistry & Biochemistry, Computer Science, Geosciences, Engineering, Mathematics, Physics & Astronomy)
2. Student must be enrolled in a minimum of 6 units in Fall of 2009.
3. Student must have completed a minimum of 60 units (upper division standing).
4. Student must be a **resident of San Francisco**.
5. Student must have a minimum SFSU GPA of 2.5.
6. Student must demonstrate a financial need.

Application Procedure:

2. A short essay of 400-600 words (*must adhere to this limit on the word count*) covering the following topics:
a) **your professional goals**, b) **reasons for applying for this scholarship**, and c) **your financial need**.
3. An e-mail recommendation from an **SFSU professor in your major field of study** to science@sfsu.edu.
4. An unofficial current copy of your SFSU academic transcript.

Evaluation of applicants will be based on the essay/paragraph, faculty recommendation, and academic record.
