

Historical Impacted Major Selection Information

The following information may serve as a guideline for Fall 2018 applicants to gauge minimum required GPAs and other requirements for impacted major admission at SF State University. All applicants who would like to be considered for admission to an impacted major have to meet the admission requirement to the University (CSU Eligibility) as well as the requirements specified by their major. The following cumulative GPA thresholds were used as a part of the selection process for the major programs. Please note, GPA thresholds change each admission cycle.

Major	Fall 2017 GPA Thresholds and Additional Major Selection Criteria
Apparel Design and Merchandizing	2.44 GPA or greater + supplemental admission requirements as stated on supplemental application
Biology (all concentrations)	2.01 GPA or greater
Business Administration (Accounting)	2.01 GPA or greater
Chemistry/Biochemistry	2.01 GPA or greater
Child & Adolescent Development (all concentrations)	2.50 GPA or greater
Design & Industry (Industrial Design & Visual Communication Design)	2.01 GPA or greater
Dietetics	2.68 GPA or greater + supplemental criteria as stated on supplemental application
Environmental Studies (Freshmen and Transfer)	2.01 GPA or greater
Health Education	2.01 GPA or greater
Kinesiology	2.48 GPA or greater
Nursing	3.00 – 4.00 GPA range in all nursing prerequisites + supplemental criteria as stated on supplemental application
Pre-Nursing (Freshmen only)	California Residents= SAT 2950; ACT 694 Non-California Residents= SAT 3570; ACT 842
Psychology	2.25 GPA or greater
Social Work	3.14 GPA or greater + supplemental admission criteria as stated on supplemental application
Sociology	2.01 GPA or greater
