



For Fall 2009 admits, testing on or before May 2, 2009

What do your scores mean?

California Executive Order 665:
If you are required to take remedial math or Intensive Reading Writing courses, you have *one year* from the semester of your admission to complete the required course(s).

EPT scores:

- 151 or higher... You may enroll in ENG 114 (Freshman composition). You may add this course during Freshmen orientation.
- 150 - 142..... You **must** take an ENG 106 (Freshman composition III) in your first semester. Add this 4 unit course during your Orientation.
- 141 - below* ... New freshmen admits **must** take a two-semester long composition series, starting with ENG 104 ((Freshman composition I); add this 4 unit course at Orientation.

ENG 104 and 106 equivalents are not available at California Community colleges. These courses are not remedial; take them at SF State.

* Non-native speakers of English should take the ESLPT. To register, visit Testing Center website, www.sfsu.edu/~testing. Non-native speakers who are first-time freshmen should consult with an advisor at orientation about taking ENG 201 and 208.

ELM scores:

If you place below 50 on ELM, you are strongly encouraged to take and pass a summer math course prior to entering SF State in the fall.
For advisement and approval of courses, contact advising@sfsu.edu

- 50 or higher... you may take a GE Quantitative Reasoning course. Add at orientation upon advisement.
- 42-48 you **must** take MATH 70, intermediate algebra, in summer 2009 at a junior college OR for Fall by adding at Orientation.
- 30-40 you **must** take MATH 60 beginning algebra, in summer 2009 at a junior college OR for Fall by adding at Orientation.
- 28 or below... you **must** take MATH 59 pre-algebra and beginning algebra, in summer 2009 at a junior college OR for Fall by adding at Orientation.
