Application Procedures

Please note that you must apply to both the University and the BECA Dept Graduate Office separately. The SFSU application must be returned to the SFSU Graduate Studies office (ADM 254). The BECA Department application must be returned to the Graduate Coordinator of the BECA Dept Graduate Office. Do not send either the SFSU application or the application fee to the BECA Department.

University Application Procedures

University Graduate Application forms and information materials, including those for international students, may be downloaded at <u>www.sfsu.edu/~gradstdy</u>, or you may write to SFSU Graduate Studies (ADM 254), San Francisco Sate University, 1600 Holloway Ave., San Francisco, CA 94132. On-line application is available at this website.

Please Note: Foreign students must submit the results of the TOEFL/TWE (Test of English as a Foreign Language). Minimum score for graduate admission is 213 on the TOEFL.

BECA Department Graduate Application Procedures

BECA Department Application forms may be obtained at <u>www.sfsu.edu/~beca</u>, or by writing to: Graduate Coordinator, Broadcast and Electronic Communication Arts Department, 1600 Holloway Ave., San Francisco, CA 94132. A complete DEPARTMENT graduate application will include the following:

- 1. BECA Graduate Application form.
- 2. Three letters of recommendation. The Department prefers that these letters be from former professors who know your university level work and can predict your success in a graduate program. Professional references, however, may be submitted if for any other reason you cannot obtain letters from former teachers. Recommenders should be able to comment on your work habits, writing ability, and other characteristics that would reflect on your ability to do well in the program.
- **3.** All college/university transcripts: You will provide the department with official OR unofficial transcripts for all university level coursework you have completed. Please be aware that the BECA Graduate Office does not receive transcripts sent to the University's Admissions Office. Therefore, you need to send these copies separately to our department. (You must also send an OFFICAL COPY of your transcripts to the University's Admissions Office.)
- 4. Graduate Record Examination (GRE) scores or TOEFL and TWE scores. All students whose undergraduate work was completed in English should take the GRE. Students whose undergraduate degree was earned from an institution where instruction was in a language other than English should take the TOEFL and TWE.
- 5. Statement of Purpose: 500 word essay. For details, see BECA Application Form.

GRE and TOEFL/TWE Exams

- (a) The BECA Department requires the verbal, quantitative, and analytical test scores of the GRE. No advanced test is required.
- (b) Information about the GRE or TOEFL and TWE may be obtained from the Educational Testing Service in Princeton, New Jersey; by calling (800) GRE-CALL; at the E.T.S. website (<u>www.ets.org</u>); or from the Testing Center, SFSU (415) 338-2271.
- (c) Remember, the report of GRE scores or TOEFL and TWE scores takes from 4 to 6 weeks to arrive after the exam is taken. The exam MUST be taken by January to meet the March 1 deadline; and by September 1 to meet the October 15 deadline. In other words, your scores MUST reach our office by March 1st for Fall admissions; and by October 15th for Spring admissions. Scores from exams taken in February <u>do not</u> arrive on time.
- (d) Exam scores more than five years old on the due date for applications are not acceptable.
- (e) When the GRE is taken, the University code number 4684 for San Francisco State University and the Department code number 4505 for Radio, TV and Film, should be given. If you use the code for any other discipline, your scores may not be received in this office in time for your application to be evaluated.
- (f) International students: if you earned your undergraduate degree in English, take the GRE exam. Otherwise, take the TOEFL and TWE exam.
- (g) It would be helpful to us if, when you receive your GRE or TOEFL and TWE scores, you would send us a photocopy. This would help us ensure that we have access to your scores in a timely manner.

The SFSU application must be returned to the SFSU Graduate Studies Office. The BECA Department application must be returned to the BECA Graduate Coordinator. **Do not send either the SFSU application or the application fee to the BECA Department.**

University and BECA application periods for United States Residents and International Students:

FALL SEMESTER Application Deadlines: November 1st to March 1st

SPRING SEMESTER Application Deadlines: September 1st to October 15th

We are aware that the University application form may list a different submission period. If so, please disregard it and follow the submission period listed in this packet. **Nevertheless**, if you are applying for Fall admissions, we strongly suggest that you submit your University application during the month of November, or as soon thereafter as possible.

Please note that applications received by the SFSU Graduate Studies Office either before or after the application period will be returned. Materials received by the BECA Graduate Coordinator outside the application period will be retained in the BECA Graduate Office.
