Students pursuing a minor in Communication Studies must take three courses (12 units), each of which is from a different one of the following breadth areas, and eight additional units selected with the approval of an advisor in Communication Studies. Courses used to fulfill Segment I, General Education requirements, cannot be used to fulfill minor requirements. With the consent of an advisor, up to eight units of other lower division units in Communication Studies may be counted toward the minor.
