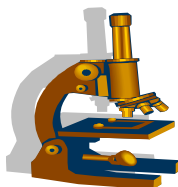

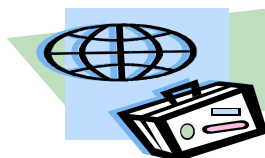
Gain insight with the "Balance Attack," GPA vs. unit load, and the proper sequencing of classes.
