Eligibility Requirements

1. Be an Alpha Gamma Sigma or Phi Theta Kappa Honor Society member or a member of the Community College campus Honors Program at a California Community College.
2. Entering Junior from a California Community College.
3. Minimum 3.0 GPA.
4. Be a U.S. Citizen or Permanent Resident.
5. Have financial need as determined by the SF State Office of Student Financial Aid. Apply or reapply online using the 2012-2013 Free Application for Federal Student Aid at www.fafsa.ed.gov (apply by the March 2, 2012 priority deadline).
6. Enroll full-time (12 units) each semester at SF State for the 2012-2013 academic year.
7. Letter of recommendation from an Alpha Gamma Sigma advisor or Phi Theta Kappa advisor or the Community College Honors Program director/advisor.
8. Write a personal statement (see reverse side for guidelines) not to exceed three pages, double-spaced, typed.
9. **Submit or mail: the completed and signed scholarship application, letter of recommendation from a honor society advisor on letterhead, unofficial academic transcript from the Community College and personal statement to the SF State Office of Student Financial Aid by Friday, March 9, 2012.**

Procedures

Completed applications that meet all of the above criteria and are received or postmarked by the March 9th deadline will be reviewed by the scholarship committee. Students selected to receive a scholarship will be notified by April 2012. Students not selected will be notified shortly thereafter.
