

Instructions for Summer 2009 Financial Aid

Limited financial aid is available for eligible students for the Summer 2009 semester. You must have a 2008-2009 Financial Aid Application (FAFSA) on file at SF State. If not, complete the 2008-2009 FAFSA on-line at www.fafsa.ed.gov. The FAFSA deadline is June 1, 2009. If you wish to be considered for summer financial aid, complete and submit page 2 of this request form by April 6, 2009. If you are awarded grants and/or loans, you will be given a registration fee deferment in time for summer priority registration. Summer 2009 award letters will be sent mid April. Financial aid is NOT available for courses taken through the College of Extended Learning (CEL) Open University.

STATE UNIVERSITY GRANT - Students who received a State University Grant or a Cal Grant during the academic year may be eligible for a State University Grant to pay summer registration fees. Must enroll in at least one course.

FEDERAL PELL GRANT - Undergraduates already receiving a part-time Pell Grant for 08-09 with remaining award year eligibility. Must enroll in at least one course.

LOANS --If you are interested in borrowing loans for Summer 2009 semester, read all conditions before responding on page #2.

FEDERAL DIRECT STUDENT LOAN - www.sfsu.edu/~finaid/newdirectloan.html

- Minimum half-time enrollment – 6 units for undergraduates and credential students; 4 graduate units for master's degree students
- Have remaining eligibility based on annual and aggregate loan limits for your class level
- First-time borrowers must complete the *Master Promissory Note* - <http://dlenote.ed.gov> and **Loan Entrance Counseling** - www.dl.ed.gov
- Disbursement date for ALL direct loans is after July 1, 2009, even for students in R1 and R2 sessions
- Last date to request a summer direct loan is July 17, 2009

- Dependent undergraduate students enrolled at least half-time – 6 units
- Parents apply to lender

FEDERAL GRADUATE PLUS LOAN - www.sfsu.edu/~finaid/newgradplus.html

- Master's degree students enrolled at least half-time – 4 graduate units
- Student applies to lender

PRIVATE ALTERNATIVE LOAN - www.sfsu.edu/~finaid/newalt.html

- Minimum enrollment is half-time – 6 units
- Student applies to lender
