

How to Find Grade Point Deficit: For Students with Overall GPA below 3.0

1. From the Transcript Find Units Attempted and Grade Points on the semester of Probation

GRADE POINTS

(The Deficit shows the number of Grade Points needed to be removed from probation. The student’s deficit is 9.0 grade points in this example. The student can be removed from probation if they complete three, 3 unit courses with an “A” or 3 “A-”s and 1 A)
