NOTES:

- (1) All rooms and apartments are double occupancy (two licensees per room) and fully furnished, unless noted otherwise above.
- (2) Student's choice of **either Payment in Full or First Installment is due with the License Agreement** prior to move-in includes a \$200 refundable security deposit and a \$30 optional activities fee (non-refundable after opening day).
- (3) A **one-time** \$40 Installment Fee is included.
- (4) All subsequent Installment payments are due by the first of each month starting with Installment #2 due on September 1, 2009 and ending with Installment #9 due on April 1, 2010. A \$20 late fee will be charged after 5pm on the third business day.
- (5) Double Occupancy rooms will have two students sharing one bedroom. Single Occupancy rooms will have one student in their own bedroom. Meal Plans are NOT included in the cost of the room.

Financial Aid Recipients: As per Title V of the California Administrative Code, § 668.165 an institution may use Title IV, HEA program funds to credit a student's account at the institution to satisfy current charges for (ii) Board, if the student contracts with the institution for board; and (iii) Room, if the student contracts with the institution for the room. Students who receive financial aid are not eligible for the Installment Payment Plan.
