




McAfee VirusScan 7.1 Installation Manual

For: WinXP/2000

Most new computers come with *McAfee VirusScan* or *Norton AntiVirus* but unfortunately these are trial versions, meaning after about three months you will not be able to update it with the newest virus definitions. The definitions are what tell the program what it needs to get rid of. When a new virus comes out a definition will be written instructing your program how to delete it. In other words, without the updates your virus scan tool becomes useless

Before installation

If you have Norton AntiVirus or McAfee installed from a new computer we recommend you uninstall it:

Click on the  **Start** button and then **Control Panel** (or **Settings** and then **Control Panel**). Once in the Control Panel double-click on **Add or Remove Programs**. This will bring up a list of installed programs. You will want to look for any *McAfee* or *Norton/Symantec* products. There might be several programs installed so remove them all. Once this is completed it will ask you to restart your computer – please do so.

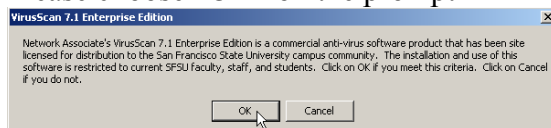

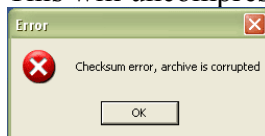
Click on “Download VirusScan 7.1” It will ask you to put in your Student ID & PAC number. Please save it to an accessible place such as the desktop.

Installing



- 1) Locate the installation file  and double-click on it
- 2) Please choose “OK” on the prompt



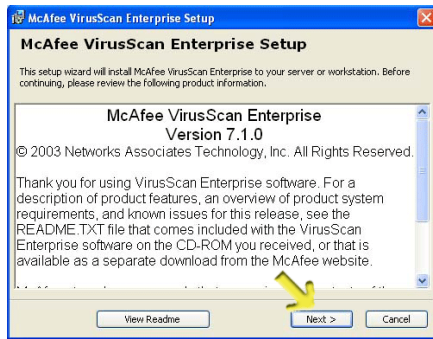
- 3) This will uncompress the installation files into a folder and then give you an error.



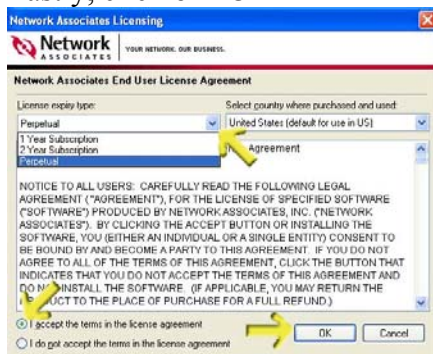
This is normal so please click “OK” on the prompt

- 4) Locate the  folder which should be below the installation file. Open this up and double-click on . This will begin the installation process of installing preliminary files needed for the program. This step can take up to a few minutes depending on your system.

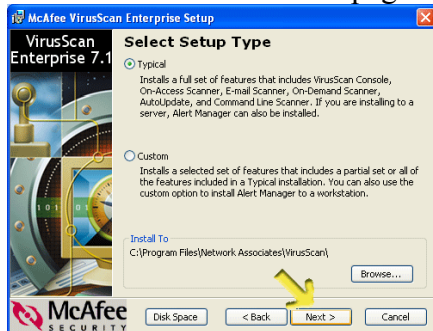
- 5) Please choose “Next >” on the first page of the Setup



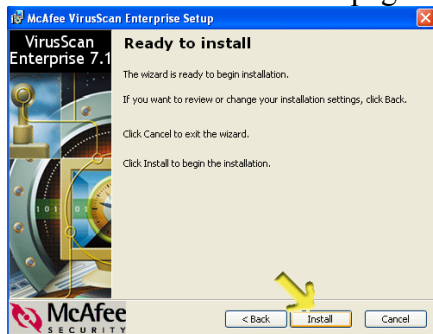
- 6) On the next page which is the End User License Agreement, you are going to need to first click on the arrow below “License Expiry Type” and select “Perpetual.” Next click the button for “I accept the terms...” at the bottom left. Lastly, click on “OK”



- 7) Click “Next>” on the next page



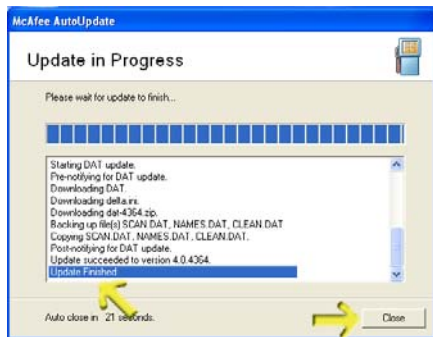
- 8) Click “Install” on the next page



- 9) The installation will take several minutes so please be patient. After it finishes the next screen will prompt you to do updates and run the scanner. It is **EXTREMELY** important to run the updater before running the scanner or else it will be of little use



- 10) When the updater finishes the last item on the progress list will say "Update Finished." Right above that it should say "Updated succeeded to version x.x.xxxx" If this is what it prompts then it worked fine. Click on "Close" and the virus scan will run



- 11) The scanner will run through your entire system. If it finds viruses it will attempt to clean them. If the clean fails you can right-click on the individual viruses and select "Delete"
