The forward jump movement occurs in many physical activities and sports. In the long jump track event, a participant's arm motion contributes significantly to the distance of flight, therefore success in the skill. In other sports, such as tennis, players must jump forward while at the net without the luxury of free arm motion. Analysis of the forward jump with and without arm motion in a kinesiology lab could help quantify how and how much arm motion helps the jumper travel greater distances.
