

Kinesiology Scholarships

Five Scholarships are available with awards ranging from \$150 to one semester in-state tuition.

Primary Eligibility Criteria:

- ✦ The Florence Hale Stephenson Alumnae Scholarship is for female Kinesiology seniors in the PE concentration who intend to enter the Teacher Credential Program.
- ✦ The FHS/Pfeiffer Scholarship is for female Kinesiology students with demonstrated financial need.
- ✦ The Harkness Physical Education Major-Athlete Scholarship is for varsity letter winners; minimum GPA of 3.00; potential as educator through teaching/coaching/leadership in the field,
- ✦ The Hal and Nonie Harden scholarship is for juniors/seniors; minimum GPA of 2.50; athletic achievement; goal of teaching or coaching.
- ✦ The Undergraduate Kinesiology Scholarship is for a full-time undergraduate kinesiology major who has completed 12 units of lecture class in the department.

Department of Kinesiology Alumnae Scholarships

Florence Hale Stephenson Alumnae Scholarship Fund

Award is one semester in-state tuition. Amount varies each year, depending upon funds available.

Eligibility criteria:

- Senior woman majoring in Kinesiology with a concentration in Physical Education, and who will enter the SFSU Teacher Credential Program in Physical Education.
- Completion of a minimum of 24 units at SFSU, including at least 12 upper division units in the Department of Kinesiology.
- Meets current GPA requirements for entrance to the Teacher Credential Program in Physical Education.
- Returning the following year to work toward completion of the California Teacher Credential Program.
- Demonstrated professional promise.
- Demonstrated need for financial assistance.

FHS/Pfieffer Scholarship

Award is one semester in-state tuition. Amount varies each year, depending upon funds available.

Eligibility criteria:

- Female student majoring in Kinesiology
- Completion of a minimum of 24 credits at SFSU
- Completion of a minimum of 9 non-activity SFSU KIN prefix credits.
- Demonstrated professional promise
- Demonstrated need for financial assistance

William Harkness Physical Education Major-Athlete Scholarship

Award is \$150.

Eligibility criteria:

- Minimum one year enrollment at SFSU in the Kinesiology major-single subject waiver program
- Senior standing in the single subject waiver program in Kinesiology
- Minimum 3.0 GPA in the major
- Minimum one season of participation and letter award winner in a varsity sport at teaching/coaching/leadership

Hal and Nonie Harden Scholarship

Award amount depends on availability of funds

Eligibility criteria:

- Full time (equivalent to 12 units) junior or senior majoring in Kinesiology with a goal of teaching or coaching
- Minimum 2.50 overall college GPA
- Leadership and character qualities
- Athletic achievement
- Demonstrated need for financial assistance

The Undergraduate Kinesiology Scholarship.

Award amount depends on availability of funds

Eligibility criteria:

- Full-time academic status equivalent to 12 units during the semester scholarship is awarded.
- Undergraduate majoring in Kinesiology
- Completed 12 units of Kinesiology lecture courses
- Award based on Scholarship, Professional Promise, Financial Need
- Award is for the Fall Semester

If you are applying for the FHS, the FHS/Pfeiffer, the Hal and Nonie Harden scholarship, or the Undergraduate Kinesiology Scholarship, submit official documentation as an indicator of your financial need (i.e. a recent tax return). The type of information is the candidate's choice, but if inadequate, the scholarship committee may ask for additional information.
