How do I get to the museum?

The Asian Art Museum—Chong-Moon Lee Center for Asian Art and Culture is conveniently located at 200 Larkin Street, San Francisco, facing City Hall across Civic Center Plaza. The museum occupies the block bounded by Larkin, McAllister, Hyde, and Fulton streets. .

Walking Directions from the Civic Center BART/MUNI Station:

The museum is located 1 block west of the Civic Center station. Leave the station by the Grove Street exit. Proceed upstairs to street level. Walk one block north on Hyde to Fulton. Make a left on Fulton. Walk one block west (toward City Hall) on Fulton to Larkin. Make a right on Larkin. Enter the museum at 200 Larkin Street.
