**Criteria:**

1. Student must have a declared major in the **SFSU College of Science & Engineering** (Departments of Biology, Chemistry & Biochemistry, Computer Science, Engineering, Geography, Geosciences, Mathematics, Physics & Astronomy, Psychology).
2. Student must be enrolled in a minimum of 6 units in Fall of 2011.
3. Student must have a minimum, cumulative GPA of 2.0 (undergrads) or 3.0 (grads).
4. Student must complete a minimum, cumulative total of 100 hours of CS/CSL\* during the time they have been enrolled at SFSU. Applications from previous winners must be based on community service hours since the last award.
5. There shall be no limitation to the qualifying service in terms of activity or intent. However, activities more closely related to the areas of science and engineering will be given greater consideration.

**\* "Community Service" Definitions:**

- Community Service (CS) may be defined as any unpaid volunteer service which contributes to the well being of the community in which the effort is directed. Most typically, community service shall be defined as an effort motivated primarily by selfless intent and a desire to give to the community.
- Community Service Learning (CSL) is the integration of community service with academic learning so that each is enhanced by the other. (There are now more than 400 courses at SFSU that offer the opportunity to participate in CSL.)

**Application Procedure:** (Make sure to include your name and SFSU student ID number on all documents)

1. A completed **Community Service Scholarship Application** (this form).
2. A short essay of 400-600 words (*must adhere to this limit on the word count*) detailing your CS/CSL experience.
3. A recommendation from one supervisor of the CS/CSL experience (include the number of hours completed)-either written or via e-mail to [science@sfsu.edu](mailto:science@sfsu.edu) (Lannie's email).
4. An e-mail recommendation from an **SFSU professor in your major field of study** to [science@sfsu.edu](mailto:science@sfsu.edu)
5. An unofficial current copy of your SFSU academic transcript.

**Evaluation** of applicants will be based on the essay/paragraph, recommendations, scope of the service, and academic record.
