SCHOLARSHIP DETAILS

The California Internship & Work Experience Association (CIWEA) would like to invite you to apply for the 2009 Bernard L. Hyink Scholarship. A scholarship in the amount of **\$1500 will be awarded for first place to one student from a 4 year university** and one from a 2 year community college in California. For the first time this year, **a \$750 scholarship will be award for 2nd place** in both categories as well. First place recipients will also be hosted for a trip to the Awards Luncheon at the 2009 CIWEA Conference – “Exploring Borders: Through Internships & Work Experience” at the Handlery Hotel in San Diego, CA on April 2, 2009. Transportation costs and one night hotel will be available to 1st place recipients only. Visit www.ciwea.org to read last years winning essays.

REQUIREMENTS

Student must write a double-spaced, word-processed, 12 point font essay of no more than 750 words addressing the following essay topic:

“Exploring Borders: How My Internship/Work Experience has Influenced My Career Choice”

Student must include a cover sheet with the essay title, your name, college or university name, and the total number of words. Without the appropriate cover sheet information, your essay will be disqualified. Essays should reflect college level writing. Your essay will be scored using a 20 point rubric that includes the following: format/neatness (2pts.), paragraph development (2pts.), spelling/grammar (3pts.), writing to topic (4pts.), creativity (4pts.), and career impact (5pts.).

In addition to the required essay and cover page, SFSU students must submit a letter of recommendation/evaluation from your Internship’s Supervisor. Click here for Supervisor’s Evaluation Form.
