

PROFESSIONAL LEVEL II EDUCATION SPECIALIST INDUCTION PLAN MODERATE / SEVERE DISABILITIES (M/S)

Candidates in the Professional Clear Level II Education Specialist Credential have 5 years in which to complete the program. During those five years, candidates must complete a minimum of 2 years of full-time teaching employment, or equivalent, in their credential area, in addition to all program requirements approved by the California Commission on Teacher Credentialing.
