## United Kingdom

The largest city in Europe, London is home to about seven million people and covers 625 sq. miles. The capital was founded by the Romans in the first century AD as a convenient administrative and communications center and a port for trade with Continental Europe. For a thousand years it has been the principal residence of British monarchs as well as the center of business and government, and it is rich in historic buildings and treasures from all periods. In addition to its diverse range of museums, galleries and churches, London is an exciting contemporary city, packed with a vast array of entertainments and shops, including The British Museum, Westminster Abbey, The Tower of London, The Tate Gallery, Hyde Park, Buckingham Palace and much more.

### *London Metropolitan University*

Established over 150 years ago, London Metropolitan University is now the product of a merger completed in 2002 with London Guildhall University and the University of North London. The end product is London Metropolitan University which offers roughly 28,000 students numerous choices in undergraduate, graduate, vocational and professional degree fields.

London Metropolitan is located in the heart of London, near the Liverpool Street and Aldgate tube stops, allowing the student to be in the thick of the thriving city. From this location, it is just a short walk to all major landmarks and sights including Trafalgar Square, the National Gallery,

and Westminster Abbey.

London Metropolitan University offers complete and thorough access to a vast amount of resources including library and research materials and information resources such as student webmail and internet access as well as study and learning resources.

London Metropolitan also has a busy student union with numerous clubs designed to appeal to almost every student interest. In addition to clubs and organizations, the University offers a wide variety of sporting activities. The University has football, volleyball, hockey and basketball teams that compete against other colleges in London. London Metropolitan offers activity classes that range from dance styles to martial arts and skiing. The University maintains an active event calendar and regularly offers events and entertainment on both campuses, including a student night recently awarded by the popular magazine *Time Out* London as "Best Student Night in London."
