## NABA: Italian Art Design

La Nuova Accademia di Belle Arti is a Fine Arts Higher Education Institution, which emphasizes a multidisciplinary approach. It is the only school legally recognized by the Italian Ministry of Education to give the "Diploma di Accademia di Belle Arti" the highest official title in Italian Art Education, the equivalent of a University degree in Industrial Design, Communication Design,

Fashion, Textile and Jewelry Design as well as Painting and Sculpture. NABA is centrally located in Milan and offers easy and quick access to historic sites such as the La Scala Theatre and Leonardo da Vinci's *Last Supper*.

The teachers at the Nuova Accademia di Belle Arti are freelance professionals, artists and designers who are all actively working in Milan, and are recognised as having both national and international prestige. The NABA focuses on the student as a "singular and unique" individual to be educated and professionally trained according to his or her own needs and to reach this objective there is a fixed limit on student numbers. Only in this way can they guarantee adequate work space and facilities so that everyone can benefit from free access to all the educational resources, a balanced and calm environment, direct and personalized contact with the teachers. This an indispensable condition for an education which is up to date and interactive as well as cultural and technical/technological, the kind of higher education needed to bridge the gap between school and work.

Have upper division or graduate standing by the end of term prior to departure.



Have the appropriate prerequisite coursework, and minimum of four semesters of college level Italian.
