Swansea is Wales' second largest city and is among the top 20 cities in Britain. With a population of approx. 200,000 Swansea enjoys the benefits of a city that is both an important commercial center and a tourist destination. The city's open air market dates back to the Middle Ages and many other shops around the Maritime Quarter add to Swansea's great charm. Swansea has cinemas, numerous restaurants offering cuisine from a dozen countries, a major art gallery, and two museums.

Swansea offers the chance to live and study in a part of Britain with its own culture, language and historical traditions. Yet London is less than three hours away by train and fast bus travel also links Swansea with London, Birmingham, Bristol, the North of England and Scotland. Regular bus tours run from Swansea to Stratford on Avon, The Cotswolds, the Lake District and Scotland.

The University of Wales at Swansea

The University at Swansea is part of the University of Wales and has about 8,000 undergraduates and postgraduates. The campus is situated in acres of parkland, just a two minute walk to the sea and a magnificent three mile long sandy beach.

Facilities at University of Swansea are top rate on both academic and social fronts. Laboratories, libraries and lecture rooms are modern and well equipped. The Taliesin Arts Centre offers theatre, cinema, buffet bar, book store, banking facilities and art gallery. The campus also boasts a well equipped Sports Centre with facilities for team sports, water sports, weight training, aerobics, athletics, martial arts and many more. The University Student's Union runs over one hundred societies and clubs; provides a general store, travel shop, laundrettes, bars, newspaper and radio station.

The University at Swansea is renowned for its friendly atmosphere and its warm welcome to international students. With more than 7% of students from outside the UK, the campus has a truly international flavor and yet unique Welsh cultural influences still show through—there is even a national *Eisteddfod*, a celebration of Welsh folk culture, held in Swansea every few years.
