Through SF State Study Abroad and the Office of International Programs, a limited number of SF State Scholarships for Overseas Study are available to students from SF State University who have been accepted to the California State University's International Programs (CSU IP) or to an SF State campus-wide Bilateral Exchange Program. Some criteria for these scholarships are:

1. Nomination or acceptance to either the CSU International Programs or SF State Bilateral exchange program for a semester or year.
2. Financial need as described in the attached application and documented with an award letter from the Office of Financial Aid when possible.
3. Intention to contribute to international education and study abroad while overseas at the host university.
4. Demonstration of ability to contribute to SF State efforts to promote international education upon return from study abroad.
5. Submission of a mid-year report while abroad, possibly for publication in the SF State study abroad newsletter The Bridge.

There will be a limited number of scholarships of no less than \$200, depending on fund-raising efforts throughout the preceding academic year. These will be disbursed at the beginning of the second term of overseas study in U.S. dollar amounts, or at the end of the first term after receipt of the student report.

Final notification of award recipients will be contingent on confirmed selection to the program of choice by SF State and the host institution abroad.
