In November of 1995, together the Archdiocese of Sydney and the Australian Tourism Group transformed St Patrick's into today's ICMS. The college honors its roots through generous donations to various international charities, and encourages its students to volunteer in various different fields.

Manly is everything Australian. Situated seven miles north-east of Sydney on the lower Northern Beaches, Manly was named by Captain Arthur Phillip after his encounter with the confident and manly Aboriginal people of the Kay-ye-my clan who lived here. Surrounded on three sides by water, Manly is the perfect destination to enjoy both the harbor and the 18 ocean beaches, coves and inlets to swim, sail and surf.

Manly is at the northern end of Sydney Harbor and has a harbor beach and one of Sydney's longest and most beautiful ocean beaches. It is an ideal 'city escape' for visitors who enjoy swimming, surfboarding or windsurfing and is the gateway to the Northern Beaches. Manly has numerous restaurants, cafes and pubs - some with discos.
