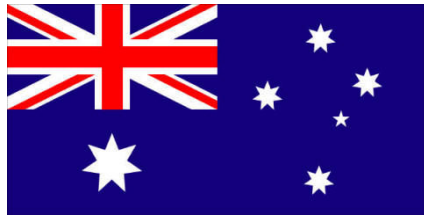

Study abroad students are enrolled as regular Deakin students, undertaking classes with Australian students. The Australian academic system is based upon the UK system. There is a range of teaching methods dependent on your discipline of study. Great emphasis is placed upon independent study outside of class contact hours. Final grades are based on written work and tests undertaken throughout semester, participation in class or laboratory attendance and final examinations.

Deakin Campuses: Melbourne, Geelong, & Warrnambool

Deakin University has five campuses in the state of Victoria—two in Melbourne, two in Geelong and one in Warrnambool. Each has a distinctive character and a strong presence in the local community. All campuses provide the services, facilities and student-centered approach for which Deakin is renowned. Your major study area may determine the Deakin campus that is best for you.

Geelong is Victoria's second largest city and boasts one of the best lifestyles in Australia, with all the amenities of a major center as well as real country friendliness. Melbourne, the capital of Victoria is only a one-hour train or drive away and some of the best (and most famous) of Australia's surf beaches, including Bells Beach and Torquay, are just 15 minutes away.

Located on Victoria's rugged Shipwreck Coast at the western end of the stunning Great Ocean Road, Warrnambool is a thriving and independent modern city—the fifth-largest in the state. Warrnambool is one of the fastest growing regional centers in Victoria and a premier tourist destination.
