**HOUSING:** Although most students studying at UTS live off campus, some exchange students coming to UTS are offered places in the UTS residences and it is worth applying. (There are approximately 800 places in the UTS accommodation and 30 000 students). Earlier applications, after you are accepted to study at UTS, are more likely to be successful. The UTS Housing Service will organise short-term accommodation for you on arrival and will help you to find longer-term housing. It is relatively easy to find somewhere to stay in Sydney and most exchange students find accommodation in shared houses or apartments during their first few days in Sydney.
