**HOUSING:** The University of São Paulo has a housing benefit system for students in need. At the São Paulo campus, for example, the Social Assistance Coordination (Coseas) keeps the USP's Housing Complex (Crusp), with vacancies for Undergraduate and Graduate students. Occupancy is distributed based on socio-economic necessity. Selection is carried out annually by the Coseas' Social Promotion Division.

Housing benefits can be requested by Brazilian students with per capita income of up to R\$ 1,500.00 a month, and by foreign students who don't receive financial assistance from their origin countries.
