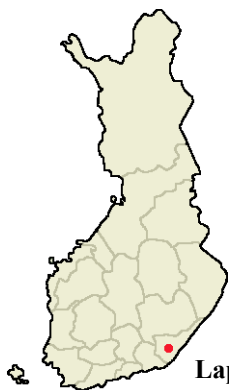

The LSB is a dynamic teaching and research unit at Lappeenranta University of Technology (LUT). The LSB mission is to combine business and technology innovatively and efficiently. LSB educates highly skilled and flexible professionals who understand the laws of economics and the importance of technology as the driving force of business. The School of Business has approximately 1,300 undergraduate (approximately 730 B.Sc.) and graduate (approximately 520 M.Sc.) students and over a hundred doctoral students.

The city of Lappeenranta is the administrative and cultural center of the surrounding province, South Karelia. Lappeenranta is a city of about 72 000 inhabitants located some 220 km northeast of Finland's capital, Helsinki (approximately 2 hours by train or car) and about 230 km northwest of St. Petersburg in Russia. Lappeenranta is both the geographical and the academic gateway from the European Union to Russia. The city covers an extensive area, stretching from the shores of Lake Saimaa to the Russian border. Its special location at the northern tip of the Saimaa Canal opens up water connections both to the Gulf of Finland and to the entire Saimaa waterway.

HOUSING:

In general student apartments are shared apartments (2-3 people). Shares consist of individual bedrooms (2-3), a shared kitchen and bathroom. The student apartment buildings have a laundry room and a sauna and most of them also have a common room. The basic furniture includes a bed, desk, dresser, and chair. LOAS buildings also contain additional facilities, including storage space for each tenant, and bike shelters. The rent can vary between EUR 200 and EUR 375, depending on size and location of the apartment and the student is also required to pay a deposit of EUR 200. Water, heat, electricity, sauna and broadband internet connection are included in the rent.
