Founded in 1971, EBS Germany, also known as International University Schloß Reichartshausen, is known for its dedication to both business theory and business implementation. EBS Germany also maintains a special campus atmosphere that strives to feel both friendly and open. In order to make the students feel a sense of belonging, the campus is made of several historical buildings, green, open spaces, and many comfortable seating areas. ### Oestrich-Winkel, Germany

Founded in 1972, the town of Oestrich-Winkel combined three previously self-governed communities called Oestrich, Mittelheim, and Winkel. The city is located on the Rhine river, and is now well-known for its wine culture. Some of the main attractions of the town include Germany's oldest stone building, the Rhine's last wine-loading crane, and the numerous follies surrounding the Schloß Reichartshausen. The area along the Rhine rivers has several historical areas that make for great sightseeing and picnicking. The town is also only a train ride away from Frankfurt.
