

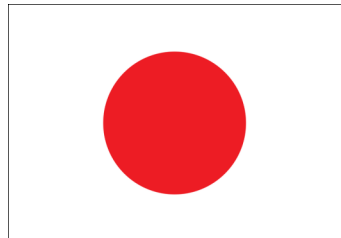

### The International Program at Oita (IPOU)

Established in 2000, IPOU offers an international education for foreign students. Classes are taught in English, and prior knowledge of Japanese is not required. Students who are interested in the Japanese language, as well as Japanese culture and society, study Japanese along with other subjects offered in English. This program provides an excellent opportunity for students to gain further understanding of Japanese culture; in addition, it offers the opportunity for a multicultural experience through students' interaction with others from around the world.

Students will be tested upon arrival to determine at which language proficiency level they will take courses. In some cases students with very advanced knowledge of Japanese will be able to take classes in university departments outside of the IPOU.

### Oita Kyushu Prefecture

The Oita Province is located on the island Kyushu, which is one of the main islands that make up the Japanese archipelago. It is southwest of the main island of Honshu. Kyushu has a mild climate, beautiful seas, and much foliage. This region is also known for its hot springs, which draw tourists from other parts of Japan to the area.

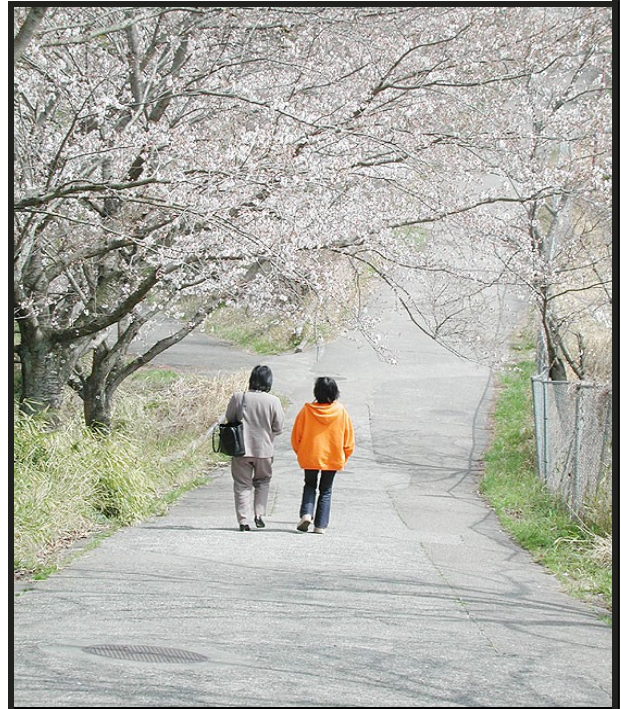
