### Rotterdam University (rotterdambusinessschool.nl)

Founded in 1990, Rotterdam Business School (RBS) excels in both International Business and Management Studies. All courses are taught in English, and RBS follows the larger Rotterdam University model of education. RBS relies on four components of education: knowledge, repetition, student emphasis, and coaching. The university approaches each of these elements from an international angle, reflecting their strong beliefs in international education.

### Rotterdam, The Netherlands

Rotterdam is the second largest city in the Netherlands municipality totaling 588,500 inhabitants 50% of whom are immigrants to the country. The city is situated on the banks of the Nieuwe Maas channel, and the Port of Rotterdam is the largest port in Europe, and until 2004, it was also the world's busiest port. At this time, the city is undergoing a renaissance including new urban projects, sparkling nightlife, and a host of festivals throughout the year inspired by the city's diverse inhabitants. These festivals range from Summer Carnival—taken from Caribbean culture—to sports marathons that attract hundreds of top athletes to underground music concerts. Rotterdam also boasts a large number of theaters, museums, and music halls for everyone's enjoyment. During World War II, most of the old buildings were destroyed, but this destruction led to an explosion of new and daring architecture, which now characterizes the city. Today, Rotterdam maintains a reputation for great architectural development and education.
