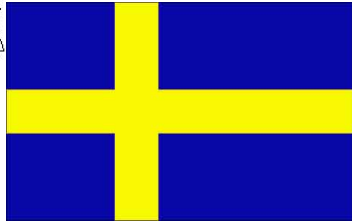
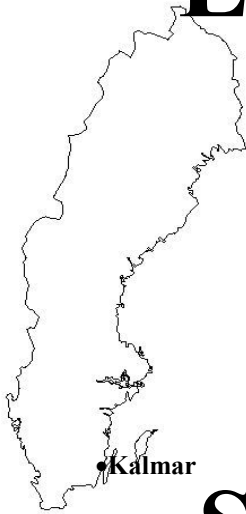


# LINNAEUS UNIVERSITY - KALMAR CAMPUS

Växjö University and the University of Kalmar merged to form Linnaeus University. This new university is the product of a will to improve the quality, enhance the appeal and boost the development potential of teaching and research, while at the same time playing a prominent role in the local community. Linnaeus University is a middle-sized university with approximately 15,000 students. It is a modern, international university with the emphasis on the desire for knowledge, creative thinking and practical innovations. In Sweden, a student studies one course at a time. Each course is five weeks long and students take four courses per term. Students can also get additional credit for the complementary 45 hour course in beginning Swedish.

### **Kalmar, Sweden**

Located on the Baltic coast in Southeastern Sweden, Kalmar is a small city with a rich history. Kalmar is the home of the "Key to the Kingdom", the name given to the magnificent Vasa fortress, Sweden's best - preserved Renaissance castle. Kalmar is set on a huddle of islands at the southeastern edge of the county of Småland, has treasures enough to make it one of southern Sweden's most delightful towns – a fact sadly missed by most visitors, who have their sights set on the Baltic island of Öland, to which Kalmar is joined by a six-kilometre bridge.
