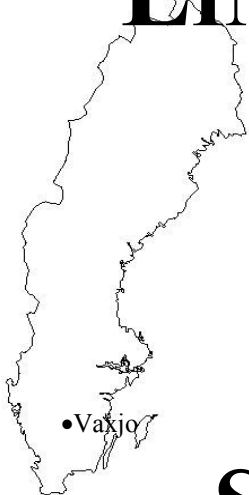

Linnaeus University (<http://lnu.se/?l=en>)

Växjö University and the University of Kalmar merged to form Linnaeus University. This new university is the product of a will to improve the quality, enhance the appeal and boost the development potential of teaching and research, while at the same time playing a prominent role in the local community. Linnaeus University is a middle-sized university with approximately 15,000 students. It is a modern, international university with the emphasis on the desire for knowledge, creative thinking and practical innovations. In Sweden, a student studies one course at a time. Each course is five weeks long and students take four courses per term. Students can also get additional credit for the complementary 45 hour course in beginning Swedish.

Vaxjo, Sweden

Vaxjo is the capital of the Kronoberg region in south-eastern Sweden. It is 200 kilometers northeast of Copenhagen and 400 kilometers southwest of Stockholm and is easily accessible by train and plane from both cities. The Kronoberg region is the heart of the traditional Swedish province of Smaland, which is also the home of the "Kingdom of Crystal," so called because of the world class glassworks located here such as Kosta Boda and Orrefors. Smaland is known for its forests, lakes, and unspoiled nature, making it an attractive area for those who love wildlife and the outdoors.

There are plenty of fascinating places to visit around Vaxjo: beautiful medieval churches and historical castle ruins. Campus also host their very own castle.
