For 70 years, the school has fulfilled these objectives in educating thousands of students who become executives, entrepreneurs, and leaders in many public and business organizations. The success of the school can be attributed to the quality of the input students, the dedication of the faculty members, and well-equipped modern facilities. Students are competitively recruited to ensure top quality input while faculty is encouraged to explore the frontiers of research and engage in practical experience so that they can transfer new knowledge to students. Modern technology is integrated into the classrooms to facilitate a state-of-the-art teaching-learning environment. All of the programs were developed to ensure that all graduates are equipped with advanced knowledge, working skills, and most importantly social responsibility. Starting from only the Bachelor program in Accounting and in Commerce at the beginning, the school has expanded the programs to cover all areas of business functions as well as all levels of study ranging from baccalaureate degree to doctorate degree. The Chulalongkorn University extends over a 456-acre tract of land and is the Kingdom's first public university. The University includes 8 Research Institutes, 13 Academic Institutes and 132 Research centers.
