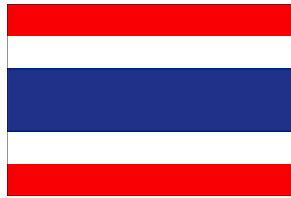

Founded in 1889, Mahidol University is one of the oldest educational institutes in Thailand. The university has over 2,600 faculty members and over 19,000 students, and is ranked as the number-one school in Thailand.

The Mahidol University International College (MUIC) contains over 2,300 students pursuing degrees in a variety of fields, and is Thailand's leading international college. Their goal is to prepare students to live and work in a diverse and globalized world while acting humanely towards others. For Hospitality Management students, the campus offers the Salaya Pavilion Hotel as a way for students to gain hands-on experience in the field. MUIC also has its own uniform that students are expected to wear while attending the campus.

Salaya Campus & Bangkok, Thailand

Located about 20 to 30 minutes outside of Bangkok, the Salaya Campus has a relaxed semi-rural feel. The campus is about 520 acres in size, and contains many of Mahidol University's research facilities. It is also within walking distance of Asia's tallest Buddha. The city of Bangkok is the nation's capital, and boasts 8 million residence, which rises to 15 million people during working hours. The city is highly urbanized, and has a very diverse culture. Bangkok is also known as one of the world's hottest tourist destinations with sites such as the grand palace that will take your breath away.

HOUSING:

MUIC is affiliated with two main dorms for housing, but students also have the option to find their own housing.

The International Houses at Chaiyapruk Village and Green Village both come fully furnished with common areas, kitchens, internet, cable TV, and laundry services. Monthly prices range from \$150 to \$220, excluding water and electricity costs (which are about \$30/mo).
