In addition, even though the program is scheduled to accommodate the schedule of a working professional, your employer or supervisor may need to approve release time/vacation time in order for you to participate in the residencies and coursework. The time committed to course work includes an 8 week Summer Session each summer, with six of those weeks committed to course work in late June through July. Professional residencies for two years requires one half day of released time for students to meet with their district consultant and university residency adviser. **Submit this form to your CSU program coordinator.**
